Generalized Hecke Groups and Dirichlet Series

Abstract: Duke introduced the groups $G(A)$ which naturally correspond to an ideal class, A , of a real quadratic field. These groups generalize the Hecke groups $G(\lambda)$, $\lambda > 2$. In this talk, I will describe two problems, which have been solved for the Hecke groups, which I am currently working on generalizing. One problem, solved by Rosen, is the description of the elements of $G(\lambda)$ by continued fractions. The other is Knopp and Sheingorn's construction of modular integrals on $G(\lambda)$ with prescribed log-polynomial periods.
